Limited Warranty and Certificate of Authenticity

The warranty set forth on this card is subject to change between the time this bike was shipped and when you purchased it. Please consult our website for the warranty applicable to this product as of the date you purchased it.

This limited warranty covers only those Ellsworth bicycle frames purchased directly from Ellsworth or from authorized Ellsworth dealers and distributors. Ellsworth Handcrafted Bicycles, Inc. warrants to the original owner, for the usable service life of the frame or two (2) years, whichever comes first, the repair or replacement of frames or frame sub-assemblies due to defects in material and/or workmanship according to the following conditions and limitations:

Two (2) year limited warranty period on all frames.

Warranty: This non-transferable warranty grants the original owner the right to repair or replacement of the frame with like technology and model without charge within the two year warranty period. This credit is towards like product only and has no monetary value. Ellsworth does not guaranty or warrant that it will continue to manufacture or sell the same type of frame that you purchased (exclusions apply, see below). Where not prohibited by law, a freight charge may be imposed for the return of the product to you.

This warranty is not meant to suggest or imply that the bicycle frame will never need maintenance or replacement parts, or cannot be broken. Replacement and maintenance parts for the service and upkeep of the original frame will be offered to the frame owner on a no-fault exchange pricing basis only, for the replacement of parts surrendered. These parts are not available to the retail public, only as replacement parts for existing frames.

Exclusions:

- All wear items to include bearings, bushings, shocks, derailleur hangers, hardware, and normal wear items or items that do not transfer to new technology replacement frames.
- Warranty excludes shocks or items not manufactured by Ellsworth as these items fall under the warranty of the component manufacturer.
- Modifications, alterations, repairs or any changes not specifically performed by Ellsworth or an Ellsworth Authorized Dealer.
- Dents or scratches caused by impact or contact during use.
- Non-conforming headtube or non-conforming bottom bracket shell after bicycle has been ridden.
- Alignment after 30 days from date of purchase.
- Water bottle bosses after 30 days from date of purchase.
- Labor and transportation charges to Ellsworth are not included. Ellsworth Handcrafted Bicycles, Inc. shall in no event be responsible for consequential or special damages outside of repair or replacement at our sole discretion. Ellsworth Handcrafted Bicycles, Inc. will not be liable for loss of bicycle use due to chronological requirements to honor this warranty.
- IN NO EVENT SHALL ELLSWORTH BE LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SUCH AS LOST PROFITS, LOST SAVINGS OR OTHERWISE ARISING OUT OF THE USE OR INABILITY TO USE THIS PRODUCT OR OUT OF ANY ALLEGED DEFECTS THEREIN, OR BY ANY ALLEGED BREACH OF THIS EXPRESS WARRANTY OR OF ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY WITH RESPECT TO THIS PRODUCT WHETHER ON ACCOUNT OF NEGLIGENCE OR OTHERWISE, EVEN IF ELLSWORTH HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

Some states do not allow limitations of incidental or consequential damages so this may not apply to you.

Proof of Purchase: Proof of purchase is required from an Authorized Ellsworth Dealer (photocopy of sales receipt) and validated warranty registration card must have been mailed to Ellsworth within 30 days of purchase, where permitted by applicable law to validate protection under this warranty.

Voided warranty: The user assumes the risk of any personal injuries, damages to or failure of the bicycle and any other losses incurred if the bicycle is used for racing, bicycle motocross, jumping, stunts or similar events. This warranty does not cover personal injuries, damages due to accident, misuse, neglect, abuse, crashes, improper assembly, poor maintenance or improper frame fit.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may have other rights which vary from state to state.

There are four critical factors to getting the most enjoyment and reliability out of your Ellsworth frame:

- 1) Proper set-up of suspension components. (Note #1)
- 2) Proper fork for your frame. (Note #2)
- 3) Seat post insertion minimum of 10cm / 4" at all times. (Note #3)
- 4) Avoid direct impacts with hard surfaces (Note #4)

Note #1: This warranty does not cover improper set up of the suspension unit (rear shock unit) which if improperly set up can cause damage or failure to a frame. Individual riding style, terrain, and technique can require specific shock unit tuning. Read the owners manual, which shipped with your bike, or you may download a copy from the www.ellsworthbikes.com FAQ section, which offers further information concerning shock set up.

Note # 2: This warranty does not cover frame damage or failure due to the selection and application of a fork with travel or length variations outside the intended or recommended fork use, travel, and length as disclosed in the owner's manual that shipped with your frame, or available on line at www.ellsworthbikes.com. Use of components, or tires that do not match the intended use of the frame, will void the warranty, i.e. DH tires or fork on an XC bike. Select the frame for your riding style, and use the bike as designed. Your frame shipped with a warning sticker that advises as to fork type and length, and frame use.

Note # 3: This warranty does not cover damage to a frame due to inadequate insertion of the seat post, or insertion and use of a seat post not properly sized for the frame. If the seat post installed in your frame does not have a minimum insertion of 10 cm, and doesn't slip snugly in the frame, it may be too short, or too small of diameter. You should contact your authorized dealer to properly size the seat post for your frame. All Ellsworth frames use either a 27.2mm or 27.4mm post to attain proper fit. It is the owners express responsibility to properly fit the post to the bike, regardless of the frames set tube actual Internal Diameter.

Note #4: Dents, dings, scratches and other cosmetic damage to the lightweight alloy tubes can be avoided by not subjecting your frame to *any* direct impacts with a hard surface.

IMPORTANT:

Bicycling is inherently dangerous. Proper equipment set up is crucial in helping to prevent equipment failure and resulting serious injury or death. Please read and understand the following warnings.

Forks, unladen, must be properly matched to frame in dropout-to-crown length, regardless of travel (check with dealer, manufacturer or check the reference list below).

| Dare | >125mm (more than 5") | No max. limitations necessary |
| Specialist | 120mm ± 20mm (4-5.5") | <600mm (less than 23.6") |

Minimum seat post insertion is 10cm, regardless of markings on seatpost.
