

## San Diego's Adventure Race Legend Robyn Benincasa Races Her Ellsworth Scant to a Top 3 Finish in the Furnace Creek 508 Road Race

Robyn Benincasa, San Diego's inspirational adventure racing and extreme sport legend, replaced her Ellsworth Truth mountain bike for a Scant road bike to compete in the Furnace Creek 508, a 508 mile road race through Death Valley with over 35,000 feet of elevation gain. Robyn finished the race third overall in the Women's Solo Class with a final time of 33 hrs and 25 minutes and averaged over 15 mph for the entire race. "That Scant rocks, I rode over 500 miles in 33 hours and I never even thought of changing bikes" added Robyn.
