Here's one answer: [Pua Sawicki's](#) 21.1 lb full suspension Ellsworth Truth mountain bike. This is the bike she uses to win things like the NORBA Marathon and 24 Hour Solo National Championships, Baja Ultra Endurance 100K, Dirt, Sweat & Gears, etc. (She races a 19lb Ellsworth Enlightenment hardtail for regular XC events).
